NEGOTIATIONS WITH TRADE UNIONS

Discussions are continuing following the February 5th meeting of representatives of the three Queensland Universities with Queensland Trades & Labour Council spokesmen representing sixteen Queensland Industrial Unions.

Substantial agreement was reached, including recognition of existing differences in staff structures of the three Universities. The parties differed, on compulsory union membership for all new members of general staff, and on the Union's initial proposal that the agreement cover all levels of general staff which was not acceptable to the Universities.

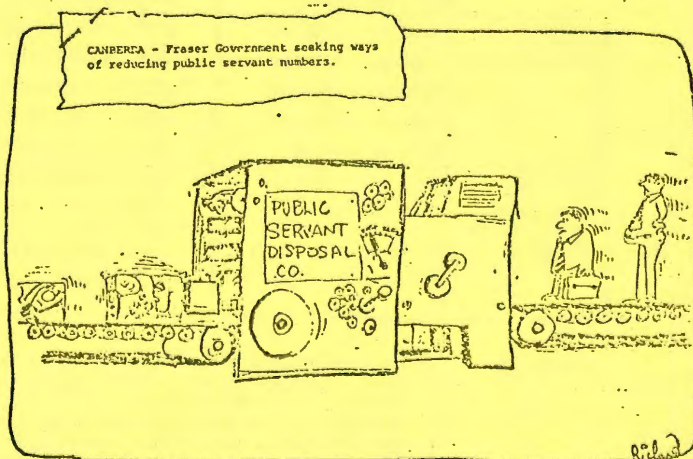
